

## OPEN STUDIES TO BACHELOR OF APPLIED ARTS IN FILM, THEATRE AND LIVE ENTERTAINMENT (FILM PRODUCTION MAJOR)

You are responsible for ensuring that your registration is complete and appropriate and that your course choices comply with the program to which you have been admitted at Red Deer Polytechnic and/or to the university to which you wish to transfer (if applicable). You are cautioned that any changes to your courses, your major or your transfer destination may adversely affect your transferable credit (if applicable), admission requirements for future programs, or eligibility to graduate from Red Deer Polytechnic. Please consult with an Advisor if you have any questions.

Students in university transfer programs are strongly advised to refer to the calendar of the university to which they wish to transfer and should contact appropriate university departments as required.

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

- ELA 30-1 or 30-2 or equivalent is required for admission to Open Studies.
- Open studies provides you with an opportunity to:
  - Explore topics of interest to help you determine which program is right for you.
  - Start taking courses that count towards another program, prior to being admitted to your goal program.
  - Take upgrading courses, if needed, in addition to post-secondary level courses.
  - You can take any course for which you have the pre-requisites, and which are not restricted to a specific program.
- Check the admission requirements for your goal program in the [Academic Calendar](#).
- Completion of courses in Open Studies will result in a lighter course load in the Film, Theatre and Live Entertainment program; however, it will not impact the overall length of the program as it will still take four years to complete once admitted.
- Completion of courses in Open Studies does **not** guarantee admission into your goal program.
- Applications for admission open on October 1, 2022 for Fall 2023. You are encouraged to apply to your goal program as early as possible.

### WHAT IS THIS GUIDE?

- This is an Academic Planning Guide, prepared by the Student Connect Centre to help you register for courses towards your desired program.
- If you are transferring to another institution to complete your degree, we strongly advise that you read the Academic Calendar of your destination institution for full information.

### WHAT IS A TERM? TERMS ARE THE PERIOD IN WHICH YOUR STUDIES TAKE PLACE. AT RDP, WE OFFER FOUR TERMS.

- **Fall** term (September through December)

- **Winter** term (January through April)
- **Spring** term (May through June): Spring term is an optional, condensed term. Course offerings are limited.
- **Summer** term (July through August): Summer term is an optional, condensed term. Course offerings are limited.

### HOW MANY COURSES SHOULD I TAKE A TERM?

- For Fall or Winter, the maximum course load is:
  - 5 post-secondary courses
  - OR 2 upgrading courses and 2 post-secondary courses
  - OR 1 upgrading course and 3 post-secondary courses
  - OR 3 upgrading courses
- For Spring or Summer, the maximum course load is:
  - 2 courses, regardless of whether they are upgrading or post-secondary level.
- We encourage you to find the best course load for you to be successful in your courses and your program! Open Studies is very flexible and you can choose a course load that matches your goals and the demands of your life.

### WHAT IF I COMPLETED COURSES AT ANOTHER POST-SECONDARY INSTITUTION?

Once you are admitted to RDP, you can then apply to have your post-secondary courses assessed for transfer credit through our [Recognition of Prior Learning Office](#). Once admitted to RDP you can complete an [RPL application form](#), provide the Polytechnic Assessors with any and all transcripts, course outlines/descriptions, or other documentation necessary to support your PLAR application.

**NOTE:** To qualify for a Red Deer Polytechnic program credential, students must complete at least 50% of the credit requirements for the credential through enrolment in RDP courses.

### REGISTRATION AND PROGRAM AUDIT

1. Some Creative Arts courses have program restrictions on them (e.g. Studio Art classes and AVFX 109). Please email [studentconnect@rdpolytech.ca](mailto:studentconnect@rdpolytech.ca) if you would like to request permission to register into any of these courses. Permission is not guaranteed and will depend upon available space.
2. Please ensure you check for pre and co-requisites.

## COURSE CATEGORIZATION/ELECTIVE LIST

To add breadth to your overall education and training students in the Film Production Major are required to complete the following electives:

- **Four (4) Creative Arts (CA) Electives** (12 credits total; 3 credits each)
- **One (1) Creative Arts History Elective** (3 credits total)
- **Two (2) Breadth (Non-CA) Electives** (6 credits total; 3 credits each)

These can be taken in any order depending upon your preferences and course availability. The remaining electives and program requirements must be completed in-program.

### Creative Arts (CA) Elective

Any **3 credit** course from within Creative Arts, plus any FILM course, which you have the pre/co-requisite to take.

Includes: ART, ARAN, AVFX, DRAM, FILM, ACT, PROD, FTLE, CREA and MUSI.

### Breadth Elective (Non-CA Elective)

Any **3 credit** course except for those listed above as Creative Arts Elective, which you have the pre/co-requisite to take.

### Creative Arts (CA) History Elective

You must take at least one **Creative Arts (CA) History Elective** in your program. *Choose one from the following:*

**FILM 201** - Film Art (*Fall only*)

**FILM 202** - Film History

**ART 201** - Art History 1 (*Fall only*)

**ART 203** - Art History 2 (*Winter or Spring only*)

**MUSI 233** - Music History (*Fall only*)

**AVFX 109** - Animation History (*Fall only*)

\*\*You are welcome to take more than one of the courses above to fulfill Creative Arts (CA) or Breadth (Non-CA) Electives.
